Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 5 Science Trip – National Space Centre, Leicester

To enrich our Science Curriculum, Year 5 will be visiting the National Space Centre in Leicester on **Wednesday 24th January**. It is an amazing museum which will really bring our topic on “Space” to life.

On the day pupils will be expected to arrive at school, in full uniform, at **8:00am**. We expect to arrive back at school around **3:30pm**. Mobile phones will be collected in and given out as normal on return.

For the day, your child will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles/chewing gum) in a carrier bag that can be later disposed of. Additionally, a coat is advisable. Pupils will be responsible for, and carrying, all their belongings. They will be allowed to make purchases from the souvenir shop and should bring their own money if you wish them to do so, to the value of no more than £10.

The cost of the coach and entrance to the centre (including the planetarium show) is £21.10. To secure this price payment will need to be made to school by **Wednesday 17th January**. Payments should be made using Parent Pay.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, please contact me via email to arrange for the school kitchen to provide sandwiches and a drink for them unless they wish to bring these from home themselves.
