**Father's Day Lunch 2023**

The cost of an adult meal is £3.00 and needs to be paid via **Parentpay**. Each child's meal is £2.40 and is payable through the normal lunch card system.

Dads are invited in over three days and two different sessions depending on your child's key stage as we do not have the capacity to host everyone on the same day. **Please note numbers are limited to 50 dads per session on payment received on Parentpay. A parent text will be sent to the child's main contact to confirm your allocated date and session in the week commencing 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2023.** Please be aware that should your preferred date and session not appear on Parentpay this will be because that date is fully booked.
